## **Background:**

The Indo-French Workshop on Artificial Intelligence, Healthcare, and the Way Forward for India and France is funded by the Indo-French Centre for the Promotion of Advanced Research (IFCPAR/CEFIPRA) and supported by the All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Delhi, India, Paris Brain Institute (ICM), France, and the Integrated Health programme (Sorbonne University, Paris, and Indian Institute of Technology, Delhi).

The Integrated Health programme is part of the Franco-Indian Campus funded by the French government to bring together universities, research institutions, hospitals, start-ups and corporate entities to jointly develop and deliver higher education and research programs in the field of life sciences for health.

- The presenting author should be highlighted in **BOLD**.
- Total Word limit: 800 words
- Abstract Structure: Title (150 characters max); Author/Affiliations; Background; Objectives; Methods; Results; Discussion.
- References format: IEEE format (e.g. [1] or [1-5]).
